A Sneak Peek at this Week!

Reading: We are learning to use sticky notes to remind us to share with our partner. While we are reading you use a sticky note to mark the page of our favorite part or something that's cool. We have also been working on retelling the story from beginning to end using our storytelling words. (First, then, next, last)

Writing: We are learning how to add the setting to our stories. The setting is the place the story happens and we need to show that in our illustrations. We continue to work on drawing us to make us look like us without missing hands or hair.

Math: We began Unit 2. It focuses on the numbers 6-10. We are working with scenes for these numbers, subitizing these numbers using a 5-finder, counting these numbers using a 5-finder. Ask your child to show you how we count using our fingers for 6-10. Your child should start counting at 5...then count on! So 8 is 5 (show hand) 6..7..8 (use fingers)
