A Sneak Peek at this Week!

Reading: This week we have been reading with our partner. We have been talking about characters and settings while reading our books to our partner. We have also been working on reading the words by using our "Super Readers"... Eagle Eye, Lips the Fish, and Stretchy Snake.

Writing: We are writing about pine trees this week, as Christmas is coming soon! We are working on stretching out the sounds we hear in words to help us write our own sentences. We call this "sound spelling". You will begin to see more of this on papers as students as beginning to become independent with this skill.

Math: We learned about hexagons this week (6 sides, 6 corners, flat, 2-D, straight lines, no curves, etc.) We have been subtizing the numbers 0-10, counting/touching one-to-one, and using 5-finders to make these numbers. We should be taking our test on this unit in December.
