A Sneak Peek at this Week!

Reading: We are learning how to talk about story parts after we finish reading a book. We spent one day chatting about characters and setting. The next day we did the events (beginning, middle, end). Then we chatted about the problem in the story and what was the solution. Finally, we put it all together and learned that this is called retelling a story. Practice retelling stories with your child after home after you read books together!

Writing: Students are writing small moment stories about themselves. We learned that we start with a title and front cover. Then we add the characters and setting to the story. Next we tell what happened first, then, and last. We are working hard on writing neatly and stretching our sounds to write the words.

Math: We worked with five-finders for the numbers 6-10. We worked with one tens-group and some extra ones to make teen numbers. We practiced addition and subtraction with our fingers and by drawing dot pictures. We also drew pictures of partners for 5 and 6 using dot pictures and a break apart stick. You can ask your child to show you how to draw partners for 5 and 6. Great Practice!
